Egypt, Western Desert, beginning of the IV Century AD: by imperial order the outskirts of the Great Oasis, along the southern frontier of the Roman Empire, are the focus of an intensive programme of exploration linked with the construction of a chain of new settlements. The largest lies on a cultivated plain at the foot of an imposing escarpment, nestled between the sandy desert and the vast dome of the sky. Isolated and self-sufficient, the Settlement is inhabited by a busy commu-nity and a group of select soldiers entrusted with the specific task of guarding the southern plain: the Settlement, in fact, marks the border of the Roman Empire. When the last handful of soldiers realises that it is time to leave the Settlement, they place a last light on the Castle tower and prepare to leave. When the last light flickers out, a cycle ends and a new one begins.
